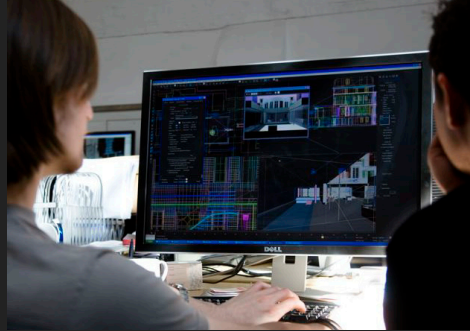

Support and training

The studio encourages artists to develop their skills to achieve their artistic goals. Personal development is supported through project based training.

The studio partners play a key role by providing project mentoring and coaching. A comprehensive review system ensures artists are always given feedback and clear goals.

Weekly team art review meetings are held and good communication skills are valued throughout the studio at all levels. Weekly seminars are held to share knowledge across the team. These range from 'crits' to presentations by experts from related industries.

The complete artist

Hayes Davidson avoids 'production line CG' where skills are split, but instead allows artists to take their work from start to finish, ensuring artists build skills in modelling, composition, lighting, texturing, rendering and finishing.

Artists have the opportunity to work with other expert professionals on a wide range of commissions that include interiors, exteriors, city studies, masterplanning and planning and press/media work.

Artists are always attributed the work they create, and are not hidden behind layers of 'account management', allowing a true sense of ownership and the satisfaction of participating in all aspects of image creation.

With project lead artist roles, regular reviews and an established promotions structure, Hayes Davidson offers talented artists the opportunity to build a career in architectural illustration.

Wellbeing

The Studio is focused on providing an environment that allows artists to be creative and to develop their work. Artists are assisted by a support team and have access to wide ranging online reference, 3D and photographic libraries as well as the HD intranet, software, AV and photographic facilities.

The studio is collaborative, friendly and provides dedicated AV room and garden spaces allowing lunches, meetings, presentations and social events. Workspaces are ergonomic, spacious and chair massage is available twice monthly.

Paddington is a prime central location and offers easy access to the West End, the City and Heathrow. The studio has memberships to many of London's best museums and encourages attendance by artists at events and exhibitions.
